THE OSTERIO MAGNO



The building, identified as the legendary "Domus Regia" of King Roger II, actually dates back later; it was built in the 13th century (on pre-existing structures) by the powerful Ventimiglia del Maro family who owned it until the early 17th century.

The construction took place in several phases, recognizable by the different architectural characteristics of its various parts such as, for example, the two-tone building whose facade is characterized by the alternation of light sandstones and dark lava stones and by the presence of three mullioned windows.

A large three-mullioned window of Chiaramonte style overlooks the main street.
