LA ROCCA (The rock of Cefalù)

On the cliff (La Rocca), 268 meters high, which overlooks the town, there is a second crenellated wall from the Middle Ages, completed in the 15th century.

In the middle of the path that leads to the top there is a megalithic structure, dating back to the 9th century, called the Temple of Diana, modified in later periods, on the back of which there is a cistern. On the top there are the ruins of a medieval fortified structure called "u Castieddu" (the castle).
